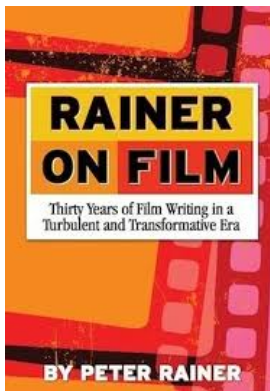
Winter Story Time Information

Sunday Afternoons in January

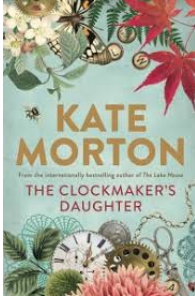


Join us for our Sunday afternoon programming featuring lecture series, films and musical programs. [See our website](#) for more information.
