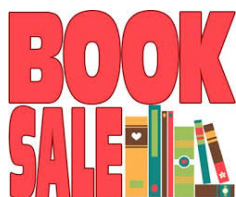

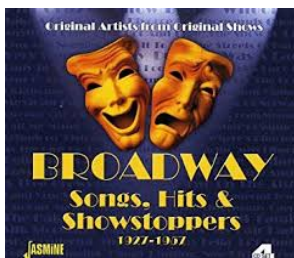


Friends of the Eastchester Library Book Sale

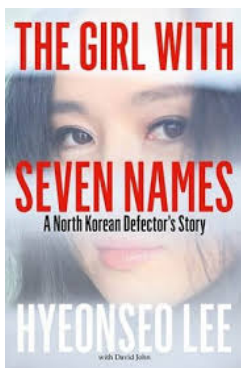


Graphic Novel Club
