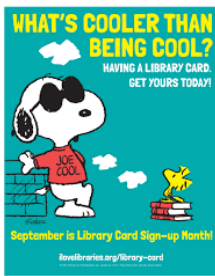

"Managing Your Career in Changing Times"



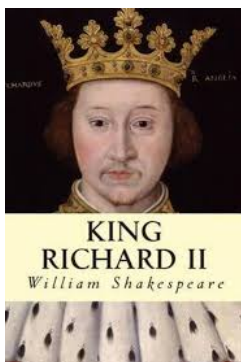
Wednesday, September 25th @ 12:00 pm

Toddler Story Time

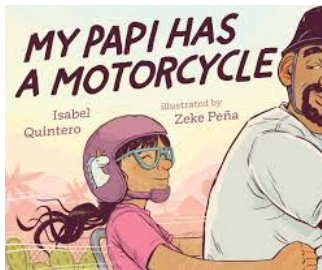
Thursdays @ 11:15 am

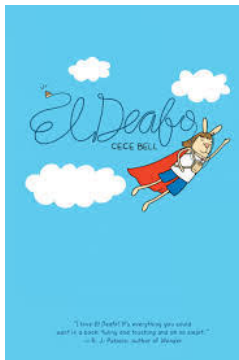
